QTA INDUSTRY AWARDS 2010 NOMINATION & SELECTION CRITERIA

PROFESSIONAL DRIVER – YEAR 2010

1. According to these provisions an award is available to recognise drivers in the industry who have been a credit to their profession through their safe driving and the general standards demonstrated through the loyalty they have shown the company employing them. (The same criteria will apply to a person in charge of a transport company who drives their own vehicles).
2. The person nominated for this award must be a Fulltime Professional Driver currently working as a local, medium or long distance driver. He or she must have:-
 - a) A minimum of 7 years continuous experience as a professional driver;
 - b) A good driving record with a demonstrated focus on safety (all speeding notices, traffic infringements and previous accidents must be declared). Nominees Driving history to be submitted with the nomination.
 - c) A high degree of pride in their personal presentation and their vehicle's presentation;
 - d) A high degree of skill and experience in freight handling relevant to their field;
 - e) A professional attitude towards their job, their customers and the industry as a whole, and;
 - f) A strong interest in furthering the professional image of the industry, as demonstrated by their actions.

INDUSTRY EXCELLENCE AWARD – YEAR 2010

1. This category is open to all Operators/Company Employees and recognises the commitment of an individual or organisation dedicated to improving the trucking industry through their operation or contribution to industry activities.
2. This distinction consists of recognising an industry employee or employer who has:
 - a) A long-term industry background showing proven positive involvement in Australian trucking;
 - b) A personal or company history displaying achievements which have been of benefit to the industry;
 - c) A selfless attitude resulting in a long-term commitment to road transport carrying a personal or organisational cost;
 - d) A proven commitment to raising both community and industry awareness of trucking,
 - e) Commitment to professional development and training of staff and;
 - f) A proven record of high integrity in relation to the trucking industry.

QTA INDUSTRY AWARDS 2010 NOMINATION & SELECTION CRITERIA

INDUSTRY SAFETY AWARD – YEAR 2010

1. This category will be awarded to an **Individual or Company** with a record of significant contribution to Road Safety.
2. The Award will recognise:
 - a) Demonstrated leadership in influencing fellow drivers, employees and or operators to improve and maintain standards of safety.
 - b) Specific initiatives being undertaken to improve and maintain road transport safety.
 - c) An attitude, which accepts that safety in particular road safety, is a priority and cannot be compromised in the interests of improved operational efficiency.
 - d) Encouragement to road safety by the introduction of accredited training and an Industry Accreditation Programme.
 - e) The raising of awareness of the need to improve driver health, driver training, vehicle maintenance and management.
 - f) Exemplary record in relation to compliance with Road Law demonstrated by the elapse of a lengthy period since any “without fault” accident.
3. Demonstrated respect for the community and other road users.

YOUNG ACHIEVER AWARD – YEAR 2010 (FOR UNDER 30’S)

1. This award category is open to any young professional who is actively employed in the trucking industry (i.e. clerical operations, management, trainee, etc).
2. **Nominees for this award must be 30 years of age or younger as at the 30th October 2010.**
3. Nominations will be assessed on the following criteria:
 - a) Personal achievement;
 - b) Impact of contributions to the trucking industry and/or their employer;
 - c) Have demonstrated leadership and/or organisational skills;
 - d) Professional attitude towards their job and the industry as a whole
 - e) Displays a high degree of skill in their particular area of the transport industry
 - f) Committed to improving and expanding their skills

QTA INDUSTRY AWARDS 2010 NOMINATION & SELECTION CRITERIA

PEOPLE LEADERSHIP EXCELLENCE AWARD – YEAR 2010

1. This award category is open to any transport and logistics company that demonstrates successful People Leadership Initiatives.
2. Nominations will be assessed against the following criteria:
 - a) A commitment to professional development and training of staff.
 - b) Education, Training and career path opportunities within the organisation;
 - c) Encouraging, promoting and employing a diverse workforce. e.g.) age, gender, and social diversity.
 - d) Promoting a workplace culture conducive to staff long term employment.
3. For assessment purposes, please forward:
 - a) One (1) example for each criteria point that demonstrates your company's people leadership initiatives.
 - b) Contact details of two (2) employees to verify nomination details.
