

Burnett Highway, Gayndah-Mount Perry and Wetheron Road intersection upgrade

July 2022

Works overview

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) is upgrading the Burnett Highway, Gayndah-Mount Perry Road and Wetheron Road intersection at Ginoondan in the coming weeks.

Project scope

The project will improve safety for through and turning traffic and includes:

- installing dedicated right and left turn lanes from the Burnett Highway into Gayndah-Mount Perry Road
- realigning Gayndah-Mount Perry Road to a T-intersection with the Burnett Highway
- realigning Ginoondan-Wetheron Road to a T-intersection with Gayndah-Mount Perry Road

The new configuration of this intersection will improve the safety of passenger and heavy vehicles travelling on the Burnett Highway at this location.

Works also include curve widening, sealing and line marking with installation of appropriate guidance and warning signage at the Burnett Highway and Gayndah-Mount Perry Road intersection, and the realigned Gayndah-Mount Perry and Ginoondan-Wetheron Road intersection.

Construction impacts

Construction of the road safety upgrade is expected to commence in the coming months and will take about three months to complete, weather and conditions permitting.

Works will generally be undertaken Monday to Friday from 6am to 6pm. Some periodic work outside of these hours may be required.

Motorists should expect some delays if travelling during work hours and are reminded to observe all warning and traffic signage when approaching the works site and be aware of changed conditions.
