

## Kessels Road and Riawena Road, Salisbury intersection upgrade

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) would like to advise that intersection upgrade works will be undertaken at Kessels Road and Riawena Road, Salisbury. These works are being undertaken to manage road congestion and improve safety.



### The project will include:

- Re-alignment of the slip lane to improve the entry angle for traffic entering from Kessels Road to Riawena Road.
- Improvement to access for pedestrians and bicycle riders, through construction of a 3m shared path through the existing traffic island.



### Timing:

- Works will commence **7 November 2022** and be completed by late 2022, weather and construction conditions permitting.
- This work will be carried out during off-peak periods to minimise impacts to motorists and the road network. This may include **night and weekend** works as required.
- Night works are required for road user safety, and to avoid what would otherwise be extensive traffic queuing and disruption to the road network.
- Night works will be carried out from **6pm to 5am, Sunday to Thursday**.



### What to expect:

- Nearby residents and businesses may experience additional noise, vibration, dust and lights from construction equipment and machinery.
- Machinery and materials may be stored on the road reserve near this site while these works are undertaken.

Upon completion, TMR officers will continue to review the site for up to three months. During this time TMR will assess the work undertaken for longevity and quality. In some cases, TMR may need to undertake further work at the location to rectify any defects.
